👺 School Start-Up Feedback

- Students are happy, teachers are energized, and administration is optimistic about the year ahead.
- Some scheduling challenges are being addressed.
- Parents asked about daily gym. Administration explained:
 - o PE/Health has **shifted**, not reduced.
 - o Previously: 30 minutes of PE/Health daily + 20 minutes recess.
 - Now: 48 minutes every other day (3 health/movement blocks + 6 PE **blocks)** + 30 minutes recess daily.
 - This still exceeds the **Alberta Education requirements** for both daily physical activity and PE/Health instructional hours.

The first two weeks of school have been filled with energy, creativity, and community spirit. Highlights include:

- **Positive Atmosphere:** Enthusiasm from staff has created a rejuvenated environment. Despite the bustle of class changes and new routines, students have been welcomed into a supportive space where they feel heard and cared for.
- Student Growth: Early lessons have focused on executive functioning, social-emotional learning, organization, scheduling, and grounding skills. Teamwork, collaboration, and problem-solving have been central to classroom activities.

 reducing the burden of large bulk orders.
- **Hot Lunch Flexibility:** If teacher strike action occurs, missed hot lunches will be rescheduled or shifted as needed to suit families.
